	Board Chair Fritz confirmed the Board answers to the law. In collaboration with the Superintendent there are internal controls in place to protect the District. Should the Board seek the District Legal Counsel it is courtesy to consult the Board Chair and/or Superintendent. Board Chair Fritz reiterated Arbor Health is a Public Hospital District and legal funding needs to align with the approved budget.	
	Board Chair Fritz noted the Board will be hosting a Special Board Meeting on Thursday, May 30 <sup>th</sup> at 11:30 am to present a webcast call <i>Commissioner Candidate Governance Education</i> . This will be an opportunity for commissioner candidates to learn responsibilities of being a commissioner and the needs of a hospital district.	
	Board Chair Fritz reiterated that the Board is committed to successfully onboarding new commissioners. The Board is putting structure in place to ensure a mentoring system assists in the success of new commissioners. The Board is committed to having processes to ensure we stay compliant at the federal and state level.	
	Superintendent Everett noted that healthcare is a complex industry that is heavily regulated. There will be a learning curve, but Administration will provide support at both the Committee and Board level.
